Award of the Qualification Based Selection to Lunceford Excavation, Inc. for 2026 Sidewalk

Recommended Motion:
"I motion to award the Design-Build Contractor selection to Lunceford Excavation, Inc., serving as the City's
construction partner in completing fiscal year 2026 sidewalk projects"
Reasons for Recommendation: Through the Qualification Based Selection process (QBS), Staff and city engineers are looking to partner with a qualified contractor to approach our 2026 sidewalk and landscape projects with a more holistic approach that includes them earlier in the concept phase during the winter to efficiently and cost effectively implement projects during the shoulder seasons of the summer. Additionally, this approach allows staff to solidify construction disturbance expectations early in the design process and communicate those expectations to the community and business owners more accurately. Staff solicited contractors to submit resumes and qualifications to be judged on the following criteria: Experience, Technical Expertise, Code Compliance Proficiency, Inspection & Quality Assurance Capabilities, Availability, Licenses & Certifications. Two qualification submissions were received by the stated deadline and after staff scoring it was determined that Lunceford Excavation scored highest based on the qualifications provided. Awarding of this selection does not award specific sidewalk projects nor the cost to execute specific
projects. Each sidewalk construction project that falls at or above the \$75,000 threshold will still come to council for approval.
 The last two years of street & sidewalk construction have provided the City a sizeable amount of unit pricing from Idaho contractors. This, coupled with the ability to negotiate and value engineer projects early on, provides the city meaningful protection against potential price gouging.



RELEVANT PROJECT EXPERIENCE

MAIN AVE REDEVELOPMENT | TWIN FALLS, ID

The Main Avenue Redevelopment in Twin Falls revitalized five blocks of the downtown core from Fairfield Street to Jerome Street, introducing new sidewalks, paving, storm drainage, streetlights, service meters, and street trees while upgrading public gathering areas with benches, furnishings, and event power. The project also delivered festival street blocks with concrete paving, structural basement infill and waterproofing within the right of way, and the Hansen Street extension to improve parking access and pedestrian/cyclist connectivity. With 97 active businesses along the corridor, careful preconstruction planning was critical to minimizing disruptions while supporting the city's economic development and long-term downtown vitality.

MOUNTAIN HOME STREETSCAPES PHASE I | MOUNTAIN HOME, ID

Phase I of the Historic Mountain Home downtown revitalization constructed four block faces of streetscapes in close coordination with ITD ahead of a scheduled mill and overlay on State Highways 30 and 51. The project balanced highway requirements with the city's goal of creating a more pedestrian-friendly environment, incorporating upgraded storm drainage for the downtown core. Completed quickly between September and December 2019, it marked the first major revitalization in more than 30 years. Despite early skepticism, careful planning and communication ensured success, transforming opponents into supporters and paving the way for future phases along North 2nd East.

MOUNTAIN HOME STREETSCAPES PHASE II | MOUNTAIN HOME, ID

Building on the success of Phase I, Phase II revitalized four blocks along 2nd East. Guho Corp worked closely with the City of Mountain Home and the design team to finalize design and secure ITD approvals, with construction completed between May and August 2020.

MOUNTAIN HOME STREETSCAPES PHASE III | MOUNTAIN HOME, ID

Phase III of the Mountain Home Downtown Revitalization built upon the success of the first two phases, which had transformed initial skepticism into strong community support. As the improvements from Phases I and II took shape, residents and business owners witnessed firsthand the benefits of increased foot traffic, revitalized shopping, and a growing dining scene. By the time Phase III began, many of the original opponents had become advocates, and local businesses welcomed our return with enthusiasm, recognizing the lasting positive impact the revitalization was bringing to the downtown core.

CCDC LINEN BLOCKS ON GROVE GMP 1-3 | BOISE, ID

This project upgrades a previously inconsistent section of Grove Street between 10th and 16th Streets, replacing aging sidewalks and intersections and reconfiguring the right-of-way to provide safer, more comfortable travel options. The design reallocates space to create a continuous protected bikeway, while integrating consistent streetscape and placemaking elements, lighting, trees, furnishings, to enhance connectivity and character in this corridor. Utility and roadway repairs were combined under one contract to reduce disruption to nearby businesses.













CCDC CAPITOL BLVD STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

This transformative downtown project reimagines Capitol Boulevard, upgrading both form and function across its corridor. Improvements include ADA-compliant sidewalks, pedestrian ramps with detectable warnings, and enhanced crossings. The protected bike network is extended, and a new Valley Regional Transit hub is incorporated. Streetscape enhancements include historic-style lighting, additional street trees and planting zones, upgraded irrigation and storm drainage, and street furnishings such as benches, trash receptacles, and bike racks. Major utility work includes replacement of the geothermal line and Veolia water main, along with upgraded pedestrian signal infrastructure at Fulton and River Streets. The project is part of a broader initiative to adapt Boise's downtown public realm to growing urban needs, supporting connectivity, vibrancy, and long-term character. Construction began in late 2024, with anticipated completion in September 2025.

CCDC KIAXO CORNER | BOISE, ID

Guho Corp recently completed Kaixo Corner, a permanent public gathering space in downtown Boise created from CCDC's Old Boise Blocks Redevelopment Strategy. Selected as the CM/GC, we collaborated closely with the design team to honor the neighborhood's multicultural heritage while managing construction in a tight urban site. The project required careful coordination with surrounding businesses, precise scheduling of multiple subcontractors in a confined footprint, and innovative solutions to construct and install one-of-a-kind public art features. Despite these challenges, Kaixo Corner was delivered six weeks ahead of schedule and now serves as a vibrant landmark for cultural events, community interaction, and everyday use.

CCDC 3RD ST STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

The 3rd Street Streetscape and Mobility Improvements project enhances a key north–south corridor in downtown Boise, prioritizing safety and connectivity for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists. The project narrows lanes along Main Street and 3rd Street to balance traffic flow, adds landscaped buffers, installs ADA-compliant ramps and curb extensions to shorten crossings, and introduces historic-style lighting and new street trees. Upgrades also include shared bike lane improvements, updated signage and markings, and enhanced pedestrian crossings. These improvements connect to the Grove Street upgrades and link residents to the Boise City Canal Multi-Use Pathway, creating a more accessible, vibrant, and connected downtown. Construction is scheduled for completion in September 2025.

CCDC OLD BOISE BLOCKS ON GROVE | BOISE, ID

Completed in November 2024, this CCDC-led revitalization project transformed Grove Street within Boise's historic Old Boise neighborhood with robust infrastructure, placemaking, and utility upgrades. The scope included enhanced pedestrian and cyclist infrastructure with raised intersections and curb extensions; wider sidewalks, sandstone benches, event power bollards, pedestrian lighting, and 44 new street trees; upgraded water, stormwater, and fiber systems; and two public artworks, "Crossroads of Boise" cast bronze sidewalk inlays and "Clepsydra" water-clock-inspired sculpture, celebrating the area's irrigation heritage and cultural diversity.





CCDC 2020 8TH & BANNOCK STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

The 8th and Bannock Streetscapes project brought together multiple agencies to upgrade road paving, utilities, and pedestrian amenities while constructing a two-block protected bike lane. Work included structural upgrades to the Hoff Building basement extending into the right-of-way, installation of fiber conduits and vaults along three blocks, ACHD signal relocation with pedestrian push buttons, and utility replacements for water, sewer, and geothermal systems ahead of a Bannock Street mill and overlay. Mid-construction, ACHD shifted from asphalt to concrete paving on 8th Street, requiring close coordination and adaptive project management. Guho Corp managed pedestrian detours, traffic control, and extensive business communications, while also collaborating with the State of Idaho on the Senator Borah statue installation at the Post Office.



CCDC 2019 STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

This project delivered two blocks of streetscape improvements along 6th Street, including Silva Cells, new curb and gutter, sidewalks, storm drainage, a concrete intersection, and fiber optic infrastructure. Block 7 Alley was upgraded with architectural colored concrete, festoon lighting, and consolidated screened waste areas, with fiber extended through the alley to serve adjacent properties. Extensive coordination with surrounding businesses ensured continued access for waste disposal and deliveries during construction.

CCDC 2018 CENTRAL DISTRICT CLOSEOUT STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

The Central District "sun setting" project closed out CCDC's first Urban Renewal District with a series of coordinated improvements, including three blocks of Capitol Boulevard streetscapes with protected bike lanes, Silva Cells, fiber conduits, new sidewalks, curbs, streetlights, trees, and brick pavers. Work also included ADA upgrades and tree/irrigation replacement on the busiest two blocks of 8th Street, hardscape and lighting enhancements in Freak and Union Alleys featuring public art elements and festoon lighting, and replacement of a geothermal main line and service connection. Construction began in spring 2018 with a strict September 30 deadline, which Guho Corp met through proactive coordination with the City of Boise and ACHD, open stakeholder communication, and a dedicated project team.



CCDC 2017 STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

Centered in the heart of Boise's nightlife district, this streetscapes project replaced sidewalks along two of the city's most active downtown blocks. Building uplights were integrated into the sidewalks to highlight the architectural character of the historic buildings along Main Street. The project scope included Main Street between Capitol Boulevard and 5th Street, a half block of Capitol Boulevard south of Main on the east side, and a half block of Main Street east of 14th Street on the north side

8TH ST MARKETPLACE STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

Working for a private property developer in coordination with CCDC, the 8th Street Marketplace Streetscapes completed the upgrades along the busy 8th Street corridor, including new sidewalks and landscaping. This challenging project required extensive public relations to maintain positive business relations, and through thoughtful planning and precise execution, construction was completed smoothly with strong satisfaction from all parties involved.











CCDC LIV DISTRICT STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

Through the CM/GC delivery method, three separate projects were combined into one master effort, maximizing investment while minimizing impacts to businesses and the public, and requiring coordination with four private developments. A key design challenge was achieving 100% stormwater retention within the district, which Guho Corp addressed with a mix of Suspended Pavement Silva Cells, permeable pavers, and seepage beds. The four phases included: expanding the geothermal system with 2,000 feet of underground pipeline and highway utility crossings (federally funded in part); reconstructing 5th Street and the Julia Davis Park entrance with Silva Cells and concrete paving; upgrading five blocks of Broad Street streetscapes with two blocks of concrete paving; and installing 20,000 feet of fiber optic raceways, incorporating custom art manhole covers in partnership with Boise's Arts & History Department.

8TH ST MARKETPLACE STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

Working for a private property developer in coordination with CCDC, the 8th Street Marketplace Streetscapes completed the upgrades along the busy 8th Street corridor, including new sidewalks and landscaping. This challenging project required extensive public relations to maintain positive business relations, and through thoughtful planning and precise execution, construction was completed smoothly with strong satisfaction from all parties involved.

CCDC 2015 WESTSIDE STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

This project was on the leading edge of streetscape product development, featuring the first installation of Silva Cell 2 in the world. Numerous Silva Cell installations were incorporated to create a suspended pavement system, greatly improving this part of downtown. The work spanned a half block of 11th Street south of Idaho Street on the west side, 15th Street from Idaho Street to Main Street on the east side, 15th Street from Main Street to Grove Street, and both sides of Grove Street between 14th and 15th Streets.

CCDC 2015 OLD BOISE STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

This five-block streetscapes project in Boise's historic "Old Boise" district was constructed in front of some of downtown's oldest buildings, requiring careful planning and collaboration to minimize disruption to active businesses. A detailed phasing plan ensured continuity for merchants while maximizing positive public response. The work included stormwater management systems added at building faces without basements, extensive curb and gutter replacement, new concrete drive approaches, and brick paver sidewalks. Silva Cell systems were installed throughout to support healthier, long-term tree growth. Project areas spanned portions of 5th, 6th, and 12th Streets, as well as Idaho and Main Streets, including key intersections at 6th and Idaho and 5th and Main.

CCDC 2012 STREETSCAPES | BOISE, ID

The 2012 Streetscapes project replaced 14 downtown Boise block faces with new sidewalks, landscaping, brick pavers, and streetlights. Structural upgrades were completed to existing vaults beneath the sidewalks to support the new improvements, and all work was carefully managed to maintain traffic flow and tenant access throughout construction.
