RV's pulling secondary cars, trailers, etc.
City Buses
Huge groups of people hanging on private property waiting for buses.
Trash left all day and night on private property.
City sweeper vehicles
Sprinter vans on all four corners blocking views
Large groups of tourists/pedestrians without rental cars walking around the neighborhood often all wearing black.
Dogs off leash, dogs on leash
Seniors and children with walkers/wheelchairs, strollers, etc.
Bicycles, E-bikes, Scooters
UPS and delivery trucks
Food delivery semis
Runners, joggers, walkers
Massive parking and business activity at a very broken post office.
Residential and other business parking and activity all along 2nd Ave.
Children playing in numerous play areas around 2nd Avenue
Snow removal issues and trucks soon
