5:14 PM - Recommendation to approve 2026 Art on 4th Call for Artists

Carter asks if anyone has any comments about the call. Rebecca mentions that some artists have a hard time finding the application and details. press releases to universities and galleries.

NEW BUSINESS:

5:17 PM - Review and discussion of financial support request to help produce 2026 Adam West exhibit by SVMoA

Carter mentions that Courtney reached out to him about the bid for painting the Forest Service Park building where the exhibit is to take place, they had not received the bid yet and they were not ready to present for this meeting and will probably present at next month's meeting. Daniel mentions that City Council approved the city to be an official partner this summer, in tandem with Ketch'em Alive and Farmers Market time frame. City of Ketchum will provide the exhibit space as well as promotional and permitting expenses.

5:19 PM - Status updates for gondola and utility box wrap call for artists

Daniel gives updates and informs the commission that the deadline has been extended to allow additional interested artists to submit. Rebecca talks about an artist who was struggling to submit her artwork because of the technology factor and Dawn mentions that she spoke with her and told her that the Utility Box wrap art submission had been extended until March. Daniel talks about the historic temporary artwork wrap that is on the gondola currently and that there has been good feedback on it.

5:23 PM - Update on percent for art code updates and direction on what revisions to make

Daniel explains that this is a follow up from discussion last year and percent for art language. Language for percent for art needs to be revised, direction from the commission is needed. Discussion, questions and comments among the commissioners ensued.

5:44 PM - Review and provide feedback on Homage to the Limber Pine City Council presentation.

Daniel presents with slides. History of the sculpture was presented and the scope of the repair as well as funding approval from City Council. Jean Pierre spoke about his concerns regarding the nature of the repair and the materials used given the local extreme temperatures. Carter responds to Jean Pierre's concerns and says he feels confident the repairs will be effective and mentions the warranty.
