ORDINANCE NUMBER 1142

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1076 BY REVISING THE COMPOSITION OF KETCHUM URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY BOARD POSITIONS AS APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 50-2001 et seq., the "Idaho Urban Renewal Law of 1965", the City of Ketchum created the Ketchum Urban Renewal Agency (the "Agency"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 50-2006 the City established a Board of Commissioners for the Agency to transact the business and exercise the powers established by Idaho Code § 50-2001 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum amended Ordinance 1045 with adoption of Ordinance 1076 to revise the composition of the board positions of the Urban Renewal Agency Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum desire to amend Ordinance 1076 to revise the composition of the board positions of the Urban Renewal Agency Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO:

SECTION 1. Amends Section 1 of Ordinance 1076 as follows:

That the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum hereby shall appoint the members of the Ketchum Urban Renewal Board. There shall be seven (7) Commissioners appointed by the Mayor with consent of the City Council. Of the seven (7) Commissioners, the Mayor and City Council may appoint no more than two (2) city council members to the Ketchum Urban Renewal Board at any one time. For members that hold the office of Mayor or Councilmember, the term of office shall be consistent with the term of office for Mayor and/or City Council member, respectively. Termination or resignation of a Mayor or a City Council member shall also terminate membership on the Agency Board. For members that do not hold the office of Mayor or Councilmember, the term of office shall be for four years.

<u>SECTION 2. REPEALER CLAUSE.</u> All City of Ketchum ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.</u> This Ordinance, shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.
