RESOLUTION 24-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL DECLARING A 2007 ELGIN EAGLE SWEEPER AS SURPLUS AND TRANSFERRING TO THE CITY OF BELLEVUE.

SECTION 1: FINDINGS

- 1.1 The City of Ketchum no longer needs the 2007 Elgin Eagle Sweeper.
- 1.2 The 2007 Elgin Eagle Sweeper has undergone substantial downtime and repairs, impacting efficient street operations
- 1.3 The City of Bellevue has expressed a need for it, and it would be put for beneficial use

Now THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ketchum that:

- 2.1. The City Council authorizes the City Clerk to dispose of 2007 Elgin Eagle Sweeper directly to the City of Bellevue. Idaho law allows for direct transfer to another Idaho governmental entity without a competitive process.
