## **Recommendation to Approve Road Closures for Special Events**

## **Recommendation and Summary**

Staff is recommending Council approve the following road closures for special events in partnership with the City of Ketchum.

# **Fourth Street between Sun Valley Road and the alley between Washington Avenue and First Avenue** Board Bin Fundraiser for Guy Coles Skatepark, 4<sup>th</sup> Street Party, September 28 from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. **Main Street between River Street and Saddle Road**

Trailing of the Sheep Big Sheep Parade, October 13 from 11:45 a.m to 2 p.m.

# "I move to approve the street closure request for the 4<sup>th</sup> Street Party and Big Sheep Parade."

The reasons for the recommendation are as follows:

- The city has assigned designated and non-designated areas for special events.
- Non-designated street closures require approval by City Council.

#### Introduction and History

Designated locations, with a user fee of \$100 per event:

- First Avenue between Sun Valley Road and 4<sup>th</sup> Street
- First Avenue between Sun Valley Road and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street
- First Avenue between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets
- First Avenue between 1<sup>st</sup> and River Streets
- 4<sup>th</sup> Street between Leadville and East Avenues
- Picabo Street between Ritchie Drive and Gates Road
- Washington Avenue between 1<sup>st</sup> and River Streets

Other areas of the city, non-designated locations, require a user fee of \$500 per event and approval for use of the street by City Council.

The 4<sup>th</sup> Street Party and Big Sheep Parade are returning events in Ketchum. These non-designated street closures were approved for both events in 2018.

<u>Financial Impact</u> There is no financial impact.
