Recommended Motion:

Recommendation to approve the award of 2025 Downtown Chip Seal project to Kloepfer Inc. Purchase Order 25082

Reasons for Recommendation:

- In the name of minimizing disturbance and negative impact to local community and businesses, council advised staff to pursue outsourcing the 2025 downtown chip seal initiative during the Mobility Master Plan on Dec. 16th
- Kloepfer Inc submitted the low bid in our public project bid opening that ended on February 14th, 2025
- Weather permitting, Kloepfer's team plans to conduct the chip seal on Mon, Tues, Wed on the week of June 16th followed by a Fog Coat on Mon, Tues on the week of June 23rd.
- Striping will be conducted during the evenings with primarily rolling closures of parking with minimal road closures for painting centerlines.

To whom it may concern,

On February 5th, 2025 the City held a optional pre-bid meeting to discuss any questions on the project. Throughout the day many questions came in via in person, email, and phone. All those questions and the City's response are below:

- Q: Can you clarify the bid bond percent for this project? A: 5%
- Q: Will there be space for storing/staging materials and equipment?
 A: Yes, the City will provide space for both within ~1 mile of the identified project roads.
- Q: Will water be available from the City?
 A: Yes, water will be available to refill your water truck(s)
- Q: Is there anywhere we can put our broomed chips and debris?
 A: The City is not supplying any location for these deposits. We suggest hauling to Ohio Gulch dump or another off-site location.
- Q: Who should be handling the community and business notifications for closures?
 A: The City will cover these responsibilities. The contractor's obligation is that changes to closure strategies and/or schedule are communicated to the City with a 48 hour notice if possible.
- Q: "CS2R applied at a rate of .40" is specified. Is the City open to alternate chip emulsions and rates? A: The City is open to discussion on using alternate emulsions if there is logical reasoning and no negative impacts. Application rates up to .43 will be accepted based on field conditions.
- Q: The specified chip size is ½". Would the City consider 3/8" chip?
 A: Due to durability benefits the City will retain the requirement for ½" chips. Alternate chip sizes are not approved.
- Q: What are the approved work hours for the project?
 A: The main incentive for the City to outsource all of this effort is in the name of getting it done very quickly without sacrificing quality. Work hours are unrestricted for this project and nighttime work is encouraged.


