Whereas, September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred thirty-ninth anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

Whereas, Public Law 915, enacted on August 2, 1956, requires the President of the United States of America to issue a proclamation each year designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week.

Now, Therefore, I, Richard E. McCraw, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of King, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23, 2026, to be

Constitution Week

I ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals held by the Framers of the Constitution in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to

us by this guardian of our liberties and remembering that lost rights may never be regained.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the City of King to be affixed this the 8th day of September in the year of our Lord, two thousand and twenty-six.
