Notice of Legislative Hearing pursuant to NCGS 160D-107(b)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at 6:00 p.m. or shortly thereafter, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, the King City Council will hold a public hearing at King City Hall, 229 S. Main Street, King, NC 27021, to consider a moratorium of sixty days or less on the issuance of any and all development approvals, including but not limited to permits, plan and site plan review and approvals, conditional rezonings, or special use permits, within the zoning jurisdiction of the City of King, for data centers, including any building or group of buildings containing one or more large-scale computer systems, networked servers, or other data storage devices for data storage, data processing, web hosting, application hosting, streaming services, artificial intelligence, artificial intelligence training, computationally intensive applications such as blockchain technology, validating blockchain transactions, cryptocurrency mining, and other similar functions and services.

Citizens may attend the hearing and provide input and comment.
