A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR TEACHER LAPTOPS
WITH DOCKING STATIONS AND PENS FOR KINGSPORT CITY
SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the city entered into an agreement with Wilson County Board of Education for cooperative purchasing in December 2021; and

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 12-3-1205(b)(2) authorizes any local government in this state to participate in a master agreement by adopting a resolution accepting its terms. If a participant to the master agreement is required to advertise and receive bids, it is sufficient that the purchasing entity complied with its own requirements. The participant is required to acquire and maintain documentation that the purchasing entity complied with its own purchasing requirements; and

WHEREAS, Wilson County Schools is a governmental entity of the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, by utilizing the Wilson County Board of Education agreement with Dell Marketing L.P. (Contract 51AHO), the city can purchase 200 Dell Latitude 5330 laptops, Dell Premium Active Pens and Dell Thunderbolt docking stations at a unit cost of \$1,005.00, \$54.99, and \$204.39 respectively for a total cost of \$252,876.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved this action on March 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from the School General Purposes budget.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the City Manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Dell Marketing L.P. for 200 Dell Latitude 5330 laptops, Dell Premium Active Pens and Dell Thunderbolt docking stations in the amount of \$252,876.00, which will be funded by the School General Purpose budget, and to execute any and all documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
