A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO TRANSFER VISION VENDOR FROM HM LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, OPERATING AS DAVIS VISION, TO METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY FOR VISION COVERAGE FOR EMPLOYEE PAID VISION INSURANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE APPLICATION AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, since 2018, the city has offered eligible full-time employees working under the authority of the board of mayor and aldermen an optional benefit of vision insurance paid fully by the participating employees; and

WHEREAS, the HM Life Insurance Company, operating as Davis Vision, has made the business decision to exit the division market, and with this change all clients are being transitioned to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for service of vision coverage; and

WHEREAS, since this is a voluntary benefit that is 100% employee funded, there is no budget adjustment necessary.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That an Application for Group Insurance Coverage is approved and the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, the application and all documents necessary and proper to transition employees to the new vision plan.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
