A RESOLUTION CHANGING CERTAIN WORK SESSIONS AND BUSINESS MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN IN JANUARY, JULY AND SEPTEMBER, 2025 IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE III, SECTION 7 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF KINGSPORT, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 7 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, Tennessee provides that the business meetings of the board of mayor and aldermen will take place on the first and third Tuesdays of each month at 7:00 p.m., unless otherwise provided by resolution or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the board of mayor and aldermen finds that due to the Christmas and New Year's day holidays it is appropriate to cancel the January 6, 2025, work session, and the January 7, 2025, business meeting; due to the Independence Day holiday on July 4, 2025, it is appropriate to cancel the June 30, 2025, work session and the July 1, 2025, business meeting, and in honor of Labor Day, the board of mayor and aldermen would like to cancel the September 1, 2025 work session and the September 2, 2025 business meeting; and

WHEREAS, work sessions are usually held on the Monday preceding the business meeting, but in honor of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday the board of mayor and aldermen would like to set a work session on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 at 4:00 p.m., in lieu of holding the work session on Monday, January 20, 2025.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That in accordance with Article III, Section 7 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, Tennessee, the board approves the canceling of the January 6, 2025, work session and the January 7, 2025, business meeting; the June 30, 2025, work session and the July 1, 2025, business meeting; and the September 1, 2025 work session and the September 2, 2025 business meeting.

SECTION II. That the board sets a work session for Tuesday, January 21, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. in lieu of a work session on Monday, January 20, 2025.

SECTION III. That the city recorder is authorized and directed to advertise the changes set forth in this resolution, and to take all acts needed to ensure that notice of the meetings are made to the public in compliance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-44-103.

SECTION IV. That the board finds the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
