A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE TENNESSEE STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ANNUAL RENEWAL OF THE SAME TO RECEIVE FUNDING FOR BOOKS, TRAINING, AND SERVICES THROUGH THE HOLSTON RIVER REGIONAL LIBRARY SYSTEM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026

WHEREAS, the city is eligible to receive fiscal year 2026 Tennessee State Library and Archives funding for books, access to online resources, professional training, use of the state-wide courier service, the automation system, and internet service through the Holston River Regional Library System; and

WHEREAS, receipt of the funding and services requires execution of a renewal of the Public Library Service Agreement with the Tennessee State Library and Archives.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS

SECTION I. That the renewal of the Public Library Service Agreement with the Tennessee State Library and Archives which provides funding for books, access to online resources, professional training, use of the state-wide courier service, the automation system, and internet service through the Holston River Regional Library System for fiscal year 2026 is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, the Public Library Service Agreement with the Tennessee State Library and Archives to receive funding for books, online resources and professional training, and allow use of courier service, the automation system and internet service through the Holston River Regional Library System for fiscal year 2026, to deliver the agreement and take any and all action as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the agreement and this resolution, said agreement being as follows:

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
