A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A TENNESSEE STATE MUSEUM CAPITAL MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027

WHEREAS, the city, through the Cultural Arts Department, would like to apply for, and receive a Tennessee State Museum (TSM) grant for Allandale, to repair and make accessibility upgrades to Allandale's freestanding bathroom, and painting and siding repairs to prevent wood decay in the Wheeler's Barn and Harvey's Barn; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the grant award being \$100,000.00 and there is no local match requirement.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That an application for and if awarded acceptance of funds from a Tennessee State Museum Capital Maintenance and Improvement grant for Allandale in the amount of \$100,000.00, is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, all documents necessary and proper to apply for and receive Tennessee State Museum Capital Maintenance and Improvement grant for Allandale in the amount of \$100,000.00.

SECTION III. That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents including those necessary and proper to demonstrate the city's compliance with the grant requirements or its provisions necessary to effectuate the purpose of the grant or this resolution.

SECTION IV. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the public.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
