A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF BOXLIGHTS
FROM CENTRAL TECHNOLOGIES UTILIZING TIPS-USA
CONTRACT 240101 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO EXECUTE PURCHASE ORDERS FOR THE SAME

WHEREAS, staff recommends the purchase of sixteen boxlights from Central Technologies, utilizing TIPS-USA Contract 240101, for use by Kingsport City Schools; and

WHEREAS, the city is a participant in The Interlocal Purchasing System or TIPS; and

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. §12-3-1205 permits city to participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of equipment; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the equipment and setup is \$53,968; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved this action on August 11, 2026; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from the School General Purpose Technology budget.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the purchase of sixteen boxlights from Central Technologies, utilizing TIPS-USA Contract 240101, for use by Kingsport City Schools is approved and the city manager is authorized to execute purchase orders for the same.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
