A RESOLUTION APPROVING A LETTER OF SUPPORT AND COMMITMENT TO THE OFFICE OF OUTDOOR RECREATION FOR A CROSSWALK AT WARRIOR'S PATH STATE PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Warriors' Path State Park would like to install a crosswalk extending from the Moody Bluff Campground to the park's visitor center, following Hemlock Road and intersecting with Fall Creek Road within public right-of-way that the city manages and has asked the city to sign a letter of support to the Office of Outdoor Recreation; and

WHEREAS, this project will provide a safe pedestrian walkway and roadway crossing for park visitors while enhancing connectivity between key recreational amenities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kingsport is committing to providing in-kind match for this project by completing the crosswalk signage and roadway striping associated with the new sidewalk.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Letter of Support to the Office of Outdoor Recreation for the Warriors' Path State Park crosswalk and sidewalk, is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, Letter of Support to the Office of Outdoor Recreation for the Warriors' Path State Park crosswalk and sidewalk, to deliver the letter and take any and all action as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the letter and this resolution.

SECTION III. That the mayor is further authorized to make such changes approved by the mayor and the city attorney to the letter that do not substantially alter the material provisions of the letter, and the execution thereof by the mayor and the city attorney is conclusive evidence of the approval of such changes.

SECTION IV. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
