A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A TENNESSEE ARTS COMMISSION EDUCATION SUPPORT GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Arts Commission Education Support Grant is for qualified non-profit or governmental arts organizations to help support arts education projects including community-based arts learning; and

WHEREAS, the grant allows the Cultural Services Division to offer arts education programming in subsidized housing neighborhoods and other underserved areas of the City, such as instruction in color theory, structure, art history, shadows and shading, and plein air practices; and

WHEREAS, this application is for funding in fiscal year 2027 for which the city has sought \$18,000.00; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement for this grant.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the application for and the receipt of the Tennessee Arts Commission Education Support Grant for fiscal year 2027 in the amount of \$18,000.00 is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, any and all documents necessary and proper in conjunction with the application for and receipt of the Tennessee Arts Commission Education Support Grant to deliver the documents and take any and all actions as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board hereby accepts grant funds up to \$18,000.00, if awarded.

SECTION III. That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents including those necessary and proper to demonstrate the city's compliance with the grant requirements or its provisions necessary to effectuate the purpose of the grant or this resolution.

SECTION IV. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
