A RESOLUTION AWARDDING THE BID FOR LYNN ROAD WATERLINE EXTENSION PROJECT TO GRC CIVIL SERVICES, INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, bids were opened June 26, 2025, for the Lynn Road Waterline Extension Project; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the bids, the board finds GRC Civil Services, Inc. is the lowest responsible compliant bidder meeting specifications for the particular grade or class of material, work or service desired and is in the best interest and advantage to the city, and the City of Kingsport desires to enter into a contract for the extension of existing waterline with 1,211 linear feet. of 12-inch DIP, 3,763 linear feet of 8-inch DIP, and all related appurtenances to serve the Lynn Road and Fieldcrest Development Area from GRC Civil Services, Inc. at an estimated construction cost of \$1,583,057.00; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified in project numbers WA2408;

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the bid for the Lynn Road Waterline Extension Project, consisting of extension of existing waterline with 1,211 linear feet. of 12-inch DIP, 3,763 linear feet of 8-inch DIP, and all related appurtenances to serve the Lynn Road and Fieldcrest Development Area at an estimated cost of \$1,583,057.00 is awarded to GRC Civil Services, Inc., and the mayor is authorized to execute an agreement for same and all documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of the agreement.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the public.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
