## Executive Summary:

The accompanying resolution <u>authorizes an application for and receipt of funding</u> from the <u>School</u> <u>Resource Officer Grant Program</u> administered by the Department of Safety and Homeland Security in the anticipated amount of <u>\$900,000</u>.

Again this year the general assembly has appropriated funding for the Statewide School Resource Officer Program Grant. This grant provides funding not to exceed \$75,000 per public K – 12 school to be used towards salary, benefits, and equipment for a full time, P.O.S.T. certified school resource officer.

The Kingsport Police Department again seeks to apply for funding through the grant in order to provide a SRO in each of the city's (12) twelve schools. The total grant funding will be around \$900,000.

There are no matching funds required.
