Executive Summary:

If approved the City Recorder will be authorized to <u>reconcile uncollectible property taxes receivable for taxes</u> assessed for Tax Year 2014.

In Tennessee property taxes are only collectible for a period of <u>ten years</u>. This requires that an adjustment be made annually for the fiscal year ending June 30 <u>to recognize uncollectible property tax receivables</u>. This includes real property, taxes on utilities, and personal property. Real property is turned over to the Clerk & Master for collection through the delinquent tax litigation process. The majority of the uncollectible property tax receivable is on <u>personal property</u>.

For Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2025 there is an adjustment of <u>\$68,335.18</u> to be made to recognize for uncollectible receivables. This amount represents <u>0.18% of the tax levy with 99.82% being collected</u>.
