Consideration of a Resolution Approving Change Order One to the DBHS Band Room HVAC Replacement Project and Ratifying the Mayor's Execution of the Same

Recommendation:

Approve the resolution.

Executive Summary:

The accompanying resolution <u>authorizes a change order</u> in the amount of <u>\$34,011.00</u> for <u>replacement</u> <u>duct work</u> as part of the HVAC replacement project for the <u>Dobyns-Bennett Band facility</u>.

On June 6, 2025, the City entered into an <u>agreement with Custom Heating & Air Conditioning LLC to</u> replace the HVAC in the DB Band Room. The total cost of the agreement was not to exceed \$175,441.00 and <u>contingency for the project is \$10,526.00</u>. Sec. 2-606 (Execution of Contracts and Purchase Orders) of the Code of Ordinances allowed for execution of the agreement without board approval.

While doing the work, the contractor discovered that the <u>exterior return duct was badly rusted and needed</u> to be replaced. This <u>damage could not be seen until the insulation was stripped off</u>. The <u>cost for this work</u> <u>will not exceed \$34,011.00</u>. Based upon the cost for this previously unanticipated work and the requirements of 2-515 (Changes in Contract Work Requiring Board Approval) and 2-517 (Change in Work, New Work Distinguished) <u>BMA approval is needed for a change order to be issued</u>.

It was necessary for the Mayor to execute the change order in order to meet the project completion date of July 18, 2025.

Funding is appropriated in the project GP2111 (Dobyns-Bennett Renovation).
