A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO AXON ENTERPRISE, INC., UTILIZING SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT NO. 101223-AXN FOR IN CAR AND BODY WORN CAMERAS FOR THE KINGSPORT POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, staff recommends the purchase of in-car and body worn cameras utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 101223-AXN for use by the Kingsport Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the city participates in the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing; and

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. §12-3-1205 permits city to participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of equipment; and

WHEREAS, in order to purchase the equipment, a purchase order needs to be issued to Axon Enterprise, Inc., in the annual amount of \$357,842.77; and

WHEREAS, funding for this equipment is available in Account #110-3030-443.20-90 will provide funding for the software and cloud storage, and Account # 110-3030-443-90-06 will provide funding for equipment costs.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Axon Enterprise, Inc. for in-car and body worn cameras utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 091219-NWY, for use by the Kingsport Police Department in the annual amount of \$357,842.77.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
