A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL
DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND
RECEIVE A GRANT FROM THE CHEMTREC FOR THE
KINGSPORT FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the city, through the Kingsport Fire Department, would like to apply for a Hazmat Emergencies Local Preparedness (HELP) grant from CHEMTREC; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the funds must be used to purchase items which will increase the Kingsport Fire Department's hazmat response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the grant award is \$10,000.00 and requires no local match.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That an application for and if awarded acceptance of funds from a HELP grant from CHEMTREC is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, all documents necessary and proper to apply for and receive HELP grant funds from CHEMTREC in the amount of \$10,000.00.

SECTION II. That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents including those necessary and proper to demonstrate the city's compliance with the grant requirements or its provisions necessary to effectuate the purpose of the grant or this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the public.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
