A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO UNITED RENTALS UTILIZING SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT NO. 040924-URI FOR THE RENTAL OF BYPASS PUMPING EQUIPMENT USE AT THE WASTEWATER PLANT INFLUENT PUMP STATION

WHEREAS, following an evaluation of the wastewater treatment plant, needed maintenance work was identified for the efficient and reliable operation of the plant, which includes the replacement of inoperable valves; and

WHEREAS, replacement of these valves requires bypassing pumping at the main pump house; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary to secure bypass pumping equipment which can be obtained utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 040924-URI; and

WHEREAS, the city participates in the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing; and

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. §12-3-1205 permits city to participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of equipment; and

WHEREAS, in order to rent the equipment, a purchase order needs to be issued to United Rentals, in the amount of \$97,716.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for this equipment is available in project account # 412-5003-501-2054.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to United Rentals for bypass pumping equipment utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 040924-URIT, to be utilized during maintenance of the main pump house in the amount of \$97,716.00.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
