Executive Summary:

If approved, this resolution authorizes the rental of bypass pumping equipment from United Rentals in the amount of \$97,716 utilizing Sourcewell Contract #040924-URI for the installation of new valves and fittings at the Wastewater Plant Influent Pump Station.

The wastewater plant influent pump house requires the replacement of inoperable valves. The existing valves are estimated to be over 50 years old. Valves are being replaced using in-house maintenance, resulting in estimated \$150,000 savings. The valves, fittings, and pipe required were approved and purchased in FY 26. Replacing the valves requires bypassing pumping at the Main Pump House.

With Sourcewell, agencies can utilize competitively solicited contracts to help save time and resources while still meeting purchasing requirements. All cooperative purchasing contracts from Sourcewell have been competitively solicited by a lead public agency and meet rigorous cooperative standards and supplier commitments.
