Executive Summary:

If approved, Kingsport City Schools will have an additional \$50,520 to provide high dosage/high impact literacy tutoring for grades 2-5 at Roosevelt Elementary and Kennedy Elementary Schools for the 2026-2027 school year.

The City has an ongoing relationship with Niswonger Foundation for the Project On-Track program which utilizes the TN All Corps Community Partner Grant to supply high-dosage/low-ratio tutoring for students who are struggling in the mastery of grade level academic skills and standards in literacy.

A budget of \$50,520 has been established. A Budget Ordinance will be forthcoming upon execution of the agreement. The allocation is listed below.

Roosevelt Elementary	\$36,400
Site Coordinator Stipend	\$4,000
Supply Allocation	\$600
