A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE ACCUFORCE HR SOLUTIONS
LLC AGREEMENT FOR TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT
SERVICES FOR KINGSPORT CITY SCHOOLS AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR
THE SAME AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND
PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE
AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City entered into an agreement with AccuForce HR Solutions LLC in February 2023 for temporary employment services for its Kingsport City Schools; and

WHEREAS, the agreement awarded to AccuForce HR Solutions LLC was for a three-year period with an option to renew on an annual basis in one-year increments providing all terms, conditions, and costs are acceptable to both parties; and

WHEREAS, both Kingsport City Schools and AccuForce HR Solutions LLC would like to renew the agreement for the term of January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, with no increase in cost or change in service during that period; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified in the School General Purpose Fund and School Nutrition Services Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved renewal of the contact with AccuForce HR Solutions LLC at its meeting held on October 14, 2025.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the renewal of the agreement with AccuForce HR Solutions LLC for temporary employment services for Kingsport City Schools for January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, a renewal agreement with AccuForce HR Solutions LLC for temporary employment services for Kingsport City Schools, to deliver the agreement and take any and all action as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the agreement and this resolution.

SECTION III. That the mayor is further authorized to make such changes approved by the mayor and the city attorney to the agreement set out herein that do not substantially alter the material provisions of the agreement, and the execution thereof by the mayor and the city attorney is conclusive evidence of the approval of such changes.

SECTION IV. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
