A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO PATTERSON POPE, INC. UTILIZING SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT NO. 110923-SPC FOR FILE STORAGE SYSTEMS AS PART OF THE JUSTICE CENTER RENOVATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, staff recommends the purchase of a file storage system to be installed in the Justice Center 2nd floor addition utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 110923-SPC for use by Sullivan county clerks' offices; and

WHEREAS, the city participates in the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing; and

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. §12-3-1205 permits city to participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of equipment; and

WHEREAS, in order to purchase the equipment, a purchase order needs to be issued to Patterson Pope, Inc., in the amount of \$98,727.30; and

WHEREAS, funding for this equipment is available in project account # GP2402.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Patterson Pope, Inc. for file storage systems utilizing Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement # 110923-SPC in the amount of \$98,727.30.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
