Executive Summary:

If approved, the <u>City will accept a donation of a 10 X 12 shelter and a 25 kW Generac generator from T-Mobile South LLC to reuse as backup power at a water pump station.</u>

Since 1999, the City has leased a portion of the property and space on the elevated water storage tank for installation of cellular communication equipment located at 224 Browder Road. The lease has changed cellular providers over the years. T-Mobile holds the current lease, but does not wish to renew.

T-Mobile inquired if the 10 x 12 electrical shelter and 25kW generator could be left on site and donated to the utility for future use. Staff desires to relocate the generator to the walnut lane pump station. The estimated value of the shelter and generator is \$20,000.
