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A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH THE TENNESSEE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AGENCY'S EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT

WHEREAS, the city, would like to apply for a Emergency Solutions Grant through the Tennessee Housing Development Agency, which will provide funds to support services for the city's homeless individuals; and

WHEREAS, the city employes a Homeless Outreach Social Worker who has administered these funds in the past; and

WHEREAS, the goal is to meet the homeless population where they are, develop relationships and provide needed services and/or referrals and each element of this grant will impact our community and help assist those who are either experiencing or at-risk for homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the city is requesting \$50,000.00 and certain documents must be completed and executed to receive the funds; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a dollar for dollar match which can be met through the salaries and benefits of existing employees and towards which the salary and benefits of the Homeless Outreach Social Worker will apply.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized to execute in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, all documents necessary and proper to apply for and receive grant funds from the Tennessee Housing Development Agency in the amount of \$50,000.00 for funds to support services for the city's homeless individuals.

SECTION II. That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents including those necessary and proper to demonstrate the city's compliance with the grant requirements or its provisions necessary to effectuate the purpose of the grant or this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the public.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
