A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM BALLAD HEALTH ON BEHALF OF ROSS N. ROBINSON MIDDLE SCHOOL AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT FUTURE DONATIONS AND SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ballard Health has committed a \$4,500.00 one-time donation to set up a reset room at Ross N. Robinson Middle School; and

WHEREAS, RNR agrees to use the funds only for the purchase of items and equipment related to the reset room project, and examples include coloring books, Play-Doh, fidget toys, etc. RNR will provide Ballard with utilization data at the conclusion of each month; and

WHEREAS, Ballard plans to support ongoing needs related to the room throughout the school year as items are used by providing smaller amounts than the initial investment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education agreed to accept the donation on November 12, 2024.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Ballard Health one-time donation of \$4,500.00 is accepted on behalf of Ross N. Robinson Middle School.

SECTION II. That the Mayor is authorized to accept future investments from Ballard Health for the Reset Room at Ross N. Robinson Middle School and in consultation with the city attorney to execute any documents necessary and properly accept the donation or to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board finds the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
