RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO RESILITE FOR A WRESTLING MAT AND WALL PAD FOR DOBYNS-BENETT HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Board of Education recommends purchasing a wrestling mat and wall pad from Resilite; and

WHEREAS, the city has been a member of Buyboard, a cooperative purchasing group, since June 2014; and

WHERAS, through this agreement allows the city to purchase goods and services directly from holders of contracts with the cooperative without conducting the bidding process, as authorized by Tenn. Code Ann.§ 12-3-1205; and

WHEREAS, by utilizing the BuyBoard agreement 665-22 with Resilite, the city can purchase a wrestling mat (\$53,909.79) and wall pad (\$26,294.04) for Dobyns-Bennett High School for a total cost of \$80,203.83; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from the Dobyns-Bennett Renovation Project, GP2111.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the City Manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Resilite Sports Products for a total purchase price of \$80,203.83, which will be funded by the Dobyns-Bennett Renovation Project, GP2111, and authorizing the City Manager upon consultation with the City Attorney to execute any and all documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
