A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO FORD OF MURFREESBORO UTILIZING STATE CONTRACT NO. 209 FOR THREE FORD TRANSIT CONNECT WAGON 7-PASSENGER VANS FOR USE BY KINGSFORT CITY SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Dobyys-Bennett High School activities program is in need of three 7-passenger vans which can be acquired pursuant to Tennessee Central Procurement Office statewide contract no.: 209 (SWC209); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-3-1201, city is authorized to purchase goods and services under the same terms and conditions of Tennessee state contracts; and

WHEREAS, the quoted price from Ford of Murfreesboro is \$32,177.00 for each vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved this motion at its meeting held on February 13, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this project will be funded by the internal funds of Dobyys-Bennett High School Activities department.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Ford of Murfreesboro for three Ford Transit Connect Wagon 7-passenger vans pursuant to the terms of statewide contract no.: 209 for use by the Dobyys-Bennett High School Activities program in the total amount of \$96,531.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
