A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FOR TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR KINGSPORT CITY SCHOOLS SUBMITTED BY ACCUFORCE HR SOLUTIONS, LLC AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, a request for proposals for temporary employment services for Kingsport City Schools was issued on October 9, 2022, and was due on November 9, 2022; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposals, the board finds the AccuForce HR Solutions, LLC is the lowest responsible compliant respondent meeting specifications for the particular grade or class of material, work or service desired, and it is in the best interest and advantage to the city, and the City of Kingsport desires to acquire the services as provided for in the proposal submitted; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified in schools' general purpose accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved entering into an agreement with AccuForce HR Solutions, LLC, at its meeting held on February 13, 2023.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the request for proposals for temporary employment services for Kingsport City Schools is awarded to AccuForce HR Solutions, LLC;

SECTION II. That the mayor or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, an agreement with AccuForce HR Solutions, LLC for temporary employment services and all other documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of the agreement and this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the public.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
