A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A TECHNOLOGY OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE PUBLIC FOR THE KINGSPORT PUBLIC LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the city, through the Kingsport Public Library, would like to apply for Technology Opportunities for the Public (TOP) Grant which will cover the cost of service for existing library hotspots for the grant's 10-month life cycle (July 2026 – April 2027); and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount of the grant award being \$2,000.00 and requires a 20% local match; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in fund 137.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, all documents necessary and proper to apply for and receive Technology Opportunities for the Public (TOP) Grant funds for the Kingsport Public Library in the amount of \$2,000.00 which requires a 20% local match.

SECTION II. That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents including those necessary and proper to demonstrate the city's compliance with the grant requirements or its provisions necessary to effectuate the purpose of the grant or this resolution.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the public.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
