A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER TO OFFICE PLANNING GROUP FOR COURTROOM FURNITURE AS PART OF THE JUSTICE CENTER RENOVATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, sealed proposals were opened February 5, 2026 for the purchase of courtroom furnishings for the Justice Center addition and renovations; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposals, the board finds Office Planning Group is the lowest responsible compliant bidder meeting specifications for the particular grade or class of material, work or service desired and is in the best interest and advantage to the city, and the City of Kingsport desires to enter into a contract for the purchase of benches, attorney tables and podiums for the Jury Courtroom, Non-Jury Courtroom and two (2) Sessions Courtrooms from Office Planning Group at an amount not to exceed \$138,327.00; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified in project number GP2402

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Office Planning Group for courtroom furnishings as part of the Justice Center addition and renovation, in an amount not to exceed \$138,327.00.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
