**Executive Summary:**  
On November 18, 2025, the BMA approved the resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute all documents necessary to Apply and Accept a Section 5307 Capital Grant (FTA-003) for Operations and Capital Assistance from the US Department of Transportation. (AF-320-2025). This request is to approve the state matching portion for the Capital Assistance Preventive Maintenance portion from the Tennessee Department of Transportation in the amount of \$20,000.

Funding Breakdown: Total projected project cost for preventive maintenance is approximately \$200,000. Projected costs per agency: Federal- (80%) \$160,000 State- (10%) \$20,000 Local- (10%) \$20,000. The funding was approved in the FY2026 budget.
