A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO  
EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR ABBA PUMPS FROM  
ABBA PUMPS PARTS AND SERVICE

WHEREAS, currently ABBA pumps are in operation at three of the city's largest sewer lift stations Kendrick's Creek, Moreland Drive and Riverport Road, which serve critical areas of the wastewater collection system and must maintain reliable, uninterrupted service; and

WHEREAS, ABBA pumps are the only pumps that can be installed at the aforementioned lift stations without reconfiguration; and

WHEREAS, ABBA Pump Parts & Service is the only authorized and recognized representative and supplier for ABBA pumps and associated parts; and

WHEREAS, staff have advised of the need to procure pumps from ABBA Pumps Parts and Service for continued operation of the aforementioned lift stations; and

WHEREAS, the city manager has determined the procurement of ABBA pumps to be a sole source purchase; and

WHEREAS, funding for the \$59,169.00 purchase is available in SW2204.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to ABBA Pump Parts & Service for the purchase of pumps in an amount not to exceed \$59,169.00.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
