Executive Summary:

If approved, the City of Kingsport will accept several donated public art pieces from Mycroft Signs, consisting of seasonal light display installations.

The proposed donation includes three Christmas public art pieces from Mycroft Signs, consisting of a walk-through ornament display, a walk-through gift box display, and a “City of Kingsport” arch light display. These pieces have a combined value of approximately \$60,000.

These donations will expand the City’s public art inventory and support the ongoing efforts of Parks and Recreation’s Cultural Services Division to enhance public spaces through public art. These pieces support the City’s growing “Christmas in Kingsport” program. This program provides seasonal displays and programming throughout the City in celebration of Christmas.

No City funds are required for the acceptance of these donations. Ongoing maintenance will be funded through existing public art funds.
