A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ROCK SALT FROM MORTON SALT, INC., UTILIZING TENNESSEE STATE CONTRACT NO.: 87297; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE SAME

WHEREAS, staff recommends the purchase of rock salt from Morton Salt, Inc., utilizing a Tennessee State Contract No.: 87297 for use by the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, local governments are allowed to use state contracts to purchase goods and services directly from holders of contracts with the state, as authorized by Tenn. Code Ann. §12-3-1201; and

WHEREAS, the rock salt is available pursuant to Tennessee State Contract No.: 87297, the city will need to submit purchase orders to Morton Salt, Inc., for an estimated annual cost of \$453,640.00, based on purchasing 4,000 tons at a cost of \$113.41 per ton, with an option to purchase an additional 2,000 tons, if needed; and

WHEREAS, the city is not obligated to purchase rock salt unless and until it is needed; and

WHEREAS, the funding is available in project/account no.: 12140244613038.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the city manager is authorized to execute a purchase order to Morton Salt, Inc., when needed for the purchase of rock salt with an estimated annual cost of \$453,640.00, based on purchasing 4,000 tons at a cost of \$113.41 per ton, with an option to purchase an additional 2,000 tons, if needed.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
