# Strategic Focus Area: World-Class Education

#### **Recommendation:**

# **Executive Summary**:

If approved, <u>a donation from the "Melissa's Hope Foundation" will be accepted and utilized by John Sevier Middle School</u> and <u>Dobyns-Bennett High School</u> to provide <u>professional development</u>, <u>supplies and equipment</u> to supplement their <u>special education instruction</u>, <u>and School Special Projects Fund budget will be increased by \$25,000</u>.

Nathan Morton has made a \$25,000 donation on behalf of his sister Melissa Foshee "Melissa's Hope Foundation". Similar donations were made in FY 2024 and FY 2025 for a total of \$285,000.

The estimated revenue for Other Local Revenue and the appropriations for the Melissa's Hope project will be increased by \$25,000.

The Board of Education approved this budget amendment at their meeting on August 12, 2025.
