A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT WITH MATTERN & CRAIG TO EXTEND THE SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR THE FORDTOWN ROAD BRIDGE REMEDIATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT; AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the city entered into an agreement on April 28, 2025 with Mattern & Craig to provide engineering services for Phase 2 of the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project, including the final design, bidding, and bid review/recommendation in the amount of \$94,800.00; and

WHEREAS, as the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project enters the Construction Phase (Phase 3), there is a need for continued consulting engineering services by Mattern & Craig, specifically construction administration services, construction support services, and construction engineering inspection; and

WHEREAS, at this time, staff recommends amending the agreement with Mattern & Craig to extend the scope of services to allow continued consulting engineering services, in the amount of \$125,000; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in project GP2608.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That an amendment to the agreement with Mattern & Craig to amend the scope of services for the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project to provide continued consulting engineering services, in the amount of \$125,000.00, is approved.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, an amendment to the agreement with Mattern & Craig to amend the scope of services for the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project agreement to provide continued consulting engineering services, in the amount of \$125,000.00, to deliver the agreement and take any and all action as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the agreement and this resolution.

SECTION II. That the mayor is further authorized to make such changes approved by the mayor and the city attorney to the amendment that do not substantially alter the material provisions of the agreement, and the execution thereof by the mayor and the city attorney is conclusive evidence of the approval of such changes.

SECTION III. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
