A RESOLUTION TO RATIFY THE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE APPROVING AN EMERGENCY REPAIR CONTRACT WITH S&W SERVICES, INC., FOR THE REPAIR OF HIGH SERVICE PUMP NO. 2, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THIS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in March of 2026, Water Treatment Plant Staff identified a critical operational issue involving High Service Pump No. 2, indicating a serious mechanical issue resulting in an immediate threat to the reliable operation of the water treatment and distribution system; and

WHEREAS, at the time High Service Pump No. 2 was removed from service, High Service #3 motor locked up, leaving only two operating pumps, posing an immediate threat to the reliable operation of the water treatment and distribution system resulting in an apparent emergency situation affecting the immediate health, safety, and general welfare of the city; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-605 of the Kingsport Code of Ordinances authorizes purchases in and for apparent or actual emergency situations affecting the immediate health, safety and general welfare of the city; and

WHEREAS, this resolution ratifies the emergency procurement of contractual services with S&W Services, Inc., in the amount of \$103,950.00 for the repair of the number 2 high service pump at the water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in O&M Budget 412-5003-501-9004.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the emergency procurement of contractual services with S&W Services, Inc., in the amount of \$103,950.00 for the repair of the number 2 high service pump at the water treatment plant is ratified, including the execution of the same by Mayor Paul W. Montgomery.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, any and all documents required for the emergency procurement of contractual services with S&W Services, Inc. in the amount of \$103,950.00 for the repair of the number 2 high service pump at the water treatment plant ,to deliver the agreement and take any and all action as may be required on the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the agreement and this resolution.

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SECTION III. That the mayor is further authorized to make such changes approved by the mayor and the city attorney to the agreement that do not substantially alter the material provisions of the agreement, and the execution thereof by the mayor and the city attorney is conclusive evidence of the approval of such changes.

SECTION IV. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
