A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR THE FORDTOWN ROAD BRIDGE REMEDIATION PROJECT TO THOMAS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, bids were opened May 20, 2026, for the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the bids, the board finds Thomas Construction Company, Inc., is the lowest responsible compliant bidder meeting specifications for the particular grade or class of material, work or service desired and is in the best interest and advantage to the city, and the City of Kingsport desires to enter into a contract for replacing sleeper slabs, expansion joints, reinforced fill, drainage systems, and repairs to south (uphill) abutment from Thomas Construction Company, Inc., at an estimated construction cost of \$807,549.00; and

WHEREAS, funding is identified in project numbers GP2608;

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the bid for the Fordtown Road Bridge Remediation Project, consisting of replacing sleeper slabs, expansion joints, reinforced fill, drainage systems, and repairs to south (uphill) abutment at an estimated cost of \$807,549.00 is awarded to Thomas Construction Company, Inc., and the mayor is authorized to execute an agreement for same and all documents necessary and proper to effectuate the purpose of the agreement.

SECTION II. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort and prosperity of the public.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
