Supplemental Information

- **Boys and Girls Club of Greater Kingsport Inc. - \$10,000**
 - Operation of competitive recreational youth basketball teams for the city with open try-outs for all age eligible city residents or KCS students. Priority given to residents and KCS students before non residents and non students.
 - Annual Reporting
- **Branch House - \$25,000**
 - Coordinates free services for survivors and provides assistance for meeting immediate and long-term needs, including medical and legal assistance. On-site services include representatives from local agencies that have been specially trained to provide assistance to people who have experienced domestic or sexual violence.
 - Quarterly Reporting
- **Children's Advocacy Center of Sullivan County - \$5,400**
 - Provide a children's advocacy center for abused children in the Sullivan County area and assist with Education/Training Coordination, Medical Examinations, Child Protective investigative Teams, Court Groups, Mother Advocate Programs and Transportation
 - Quarterly Reporting
- **Downtown Kingsport Association - \$90,000**
 - Assist in the implementation of city policies and objectives for downtown, maintain Main Street Certification, undertake marketing program for downtown, assist with education for downtown stakeholders, assist Chamber and ED office with promotion of vacant buildings, facilitate installation of seasonal décor and produce events that promote the downtown.
 - Quarterly Reporting
- **First Tennessee Development District - \$6,374**
 - Serves as a liaison for local governments, assist with data collection services, regional plan preparations, project implementation activities, grants management, and technical assistance.
 - Quarterly Reporting
- **First Tennessee Human Resource Agency - \$9,212**
 - Provides basic homemaker services including personalized training in cleaning, cooking, personal care, laundry grocery shopping, educational assistance, medication pickup and monitoring, transportation, coordination with other public services.

- **Holston Business Development Center – \$33,840**
 - Promote, coordinate, develop and operate the Small Business Incubator Program.
 - Quarterly Reporting

- **Kingsport Ballet** - \$14,880
 - Provides free of charge classical ballet instruction to underserved children in the community through its Developing Artists and Nurturing Cultural Education through Community Outreach program.
 - Quarterly Reporting

- **Kingsport Chamber Foundation** - \$227,540
 - Develops and Carrys out programs/services related to a clean and beautiful environment, positive health outcomes and information related to improved health for citizens, small business development and entrepreneurship, recruitment of quality residents to Kingsport.
 - Quarterly Reporting

- **Kingsport Convention and Visitors Bureau** - \$140,000 + 62.5% of 7% Hotel/Motel Tax
 - Responsible for increasing tourism revenue through the continued promotion of Kingsport as a destination for conventions, amateur athletics, business, leisure travelers, special events and any other tourism related events. Also responsible for the Twilight Alive Concert Series, Red White and BOOM, and FunFest.
 - Annual Reporting

- **Kingsport Theatre Guild** - \$7,200
 - Produce and present community-wide productions with staff and actors from the Greater Tri-Cities area. Hosts a youth camp and teen camp in the summer and partners with Barter Youth Academy for workshops in the fall, spring and summer targeting a young audience.

- **Petworks** - \$400,000
 - Provides for an Animal Control/Shelter Program for the City.
 - Monthly Reporting and Annual Presentation

- **Symphony of the Mountains** - \$7,500
 - Funding for a concert chair for Symphony of the Mountains Association.
