Executive Summary:

If approved the City will enter into a partnership agreement with various agencies and organizations for services in the fiscal year 2026-2027 benefiting the general welfare of Kingsport residents. The agencies are listed below:

- Boys and Girls Club of Greater Kingsport Inc. - \$10,000
- Branch House - \$25,000
- Children’s Advocacy Center of Sullivan County - \$5,400
- Downtown Kingsport Association - \$90,000
- First Tennessee Development District - \$6,374
- First Tennessee Human Resource Agency - \$9,212
- Holston Business Development Center – \$33,840
- Kingsport Ballet - \$14,880
- Kingsport Chamber Foundation - \$227,540
- Kingsport Convention and Visitors Bureau - \$140,000 + 62.5% of 7% Hotel/Motel Tax
- Kingsport Theatre Guild - \$7,200
- Petworks - \$400,000
- Symphony of the Mountains - \$7,500
