A RESOLUTION TO RATIFY THE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE ON ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE A 2026 TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE PUBLIC GRANT FOR THE KINGSPORT PUBLIC LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the city applied for a Training Opportunity for the Public Grant(TOP) through the Tennessee State Library and Archives (TSLA), which will provide funds for digital literacy training, hotspots, solar charging tables and internal connections; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the grant funds will be used by the Kingsport Public Library (KPL) to purchase six Wi-Fi hotspots, accompanying device cases, and a year of service; and .

WHEREAS, the grant is in the amount of \$4,800.00 which requires a 20% match; and

WHEREAS, the local match funds are available in the KPL operations budget; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for the grant application was March 31, 2025.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the application submitted on March 31, 2025, for a Training Opportunity for the Public Grant(TOP) through the Tennessee State Library and Archives (TSLA), in an amount of \$4,800.00, requiring a 20% match is ratified, including the execution of the same by Mayor Paul W. Montgomery.

SECTION II. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice mayor, is authorized to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney, and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, all documents necessary and proper to apply for and receive a Training Opportunity for the Public Grant(TOP) through the Tennessee State Library and Archives (TSLA), in an amount of \$4,800.00, requiring a 20% match.

SECTION III. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
