A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE AWARD OF BID FOR SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS TO ALL CITY MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC.; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND PROPER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2018, the board adopted Resolution No. 2018-192, awarding bids for the acquisition of school crossing guard services; and

WHEREAS, the invitation to bid included a renewal option clause that allows the city to renew the award for an additional twelve month period, if costs are acceptable to both parties, and with board approval; and

WHEREAS, All City Management Services, Inc. has agreed to renew the agreement for the period of twelve months, beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, with a cost of living index increase and breakfast program increase, and staff recommends renewing the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the funding is identified in the Police Department Budget, Account No.: 110-3001-441-2020.

WHEREAS, the Police Department and Kingsport City Schools are in an agreement to amend the interdepartmental Memorandum of Understanding, which provides for the acquisition, management, and funding of crossing guards, to show the increase; and

WHEREAS, Kingsport City Schools shall transfer funds from one of its accounts to the Police Department Budget, Account No.: 110-3001-441-2020 for payment of the contracted crossing guard services incurred by the Police Department.

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the Consent Assignment Agreement with All City Management Services, Inc., executed on March 14, 2025, to continue school crossing guard services without interruption is approved.

SECTION II. That the amendment to the agreement renewing the award of bid for the school crossing guard services with All City Management Services, Inc. for an additional year, with an increase for cost of living and the school breakfast program is approved.

SECTION III. That the mayor, or in his absence, incapacity, or failure to act, the vice-mayor, is authorized and directed to execute, in a form approved by the city attorney and subject to the requirements of Article X, Section 10 of the Charter of the City of Kingsport, the amendment to the agreement renewing the award of bid for the school crossing guard services with All City Management Services, Inc. for an additional year with an increase for cost of living and the school breakfast program, to deliver the agreement and take any and all action as may be required on

the part of the city to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the transactions contemplated by the agreement and this resolution.

SECTION IV. That the board finds that the actions authorized by this resolution are for a public purpose and will promote the health, comfort, and prosperity of the citizens of the city.

SECTION VI. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the public welfare requiring it.
