Executive Summary:

If approved, a new downtown mural will be located at 201 Broad Street. The owner of 201 Broad Street has requested approval for a mural to be attached to his building. Murals proposed in the B-2 zone require approval from the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Criteria for murals is found in the B-2, Central Business District, section of the Zoning Code. Murals are required to be placed on a wall and not contain references to the premises or to the products and/or services offered for sale on the premises. The mural will be 8x8 and painted attached to the E. Market Street side of the building. The mural conforms to the criteria set forth in the Zoning Code.

Supplemental information is provided depicting the map location of the mural as well as rendering of the artwork. A mural of a similar nature was previously located at this location.
