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#### **Strategic Focus Area: 3. Exceptional Cultural & Recreational Opportunities**

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**Recommendation:** Approve the Resolution

**Executive Summary:**

If approved, the Kingsport Aquatic Center (KAC) will purchase a new Colorado Time Systems GEN7 competitive timing system, associated competition equipment, and two LED video display boards in the approximant amount of \$214,132 through TIPS Contract No. 250901.

The existing timing system is no longer supported by the manufacturer. Replacement parts, service support, and software upgrades have become increasingly limited, creating reliability concerns and jeopardizing the facility's ability to host collegiate-level swim meets.

The proposed replacement includes a modern timing system, championship starting equipment, relay judging platforms, touchpads, and two full-color LED video display boards that will enhance meet operations and improve the experience for athletes and spectators.

While the LED display boards and their installation are included in this purchase, installation cannot occur until a separate structural improvement project is completed to support the new equipment. Thompson & Litton is currently designing the structural system necessary to safely mount the displays within the Aquatic Center. Because the display boards have extended lead times, up to 25 weeks, and the Aquatic Center is scheduled to host collegiate meets in February 2027, staff recommends purchasing the equipment now, so it is available for installation immediately upon completion of the structural improvements.

The equipment is purchased from The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Contract No. 250901.

Funding is forthcoming from the Aquatics Center debt issuance in AF-232-2026.
